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2/ Letter of Nguyen Xuan Hao dated 20 Feb 65 to Nua, Ta Baul Village unit, asking Nua to give to the bearer of the letter 4000 rounds of K50 ammo and 1000 rounds of M44 rifle ammo.

3/ Letter of introduction dated 8 March 65 signed by Nguyen Xuan Hao, introducing Le Tai leader of a team of 7 men, going to meet Nua in order to pick up some ammunition.

Circular

Circular # 64 HQ of Quang Nam - Da Nang Economy-Finance Section dated 22 Nov 64, signed by Thanh Tam, deciding the planting of manioc and potatoes at the end of 1964 and beginning of 1965 to alleviate the consequences of the recent flood.

Memorandum

Memorandum # 74/VPTC dated 21 March 65, signed by DUC LAM, Chief of HQ9 to Economical Section of various low land districts, and cities, true copy signed by Nguyen Xuan Hao, informing them of the following:

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1/ Agricultural taxes levied on paddy: from 5 to 6% a kilo depending on local price.

2/ RVN plan to disguise its troops as VC to collect taxes, also VC tax receipts, forged by RVN.

3/ Unsettled RVN agricultural credit loans should be turned into the VC.

- Loans and interest by wealthy farmers.
- Loans only by middle and poor farmers.
- None by flood victims.

Notebook

Listing of items received from relatives of persons (status unknown) held prisoner by the VC. No indication given as to where prisoners are being held, whether they are civilian or military, or where the owner of the notebook was stationed.

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List contains prisoner names, age, name of village or hamlet, and contents of gift or sum of money sent. List contains 1/4 names.

1/ Listing of daily unit strength at the frontline and at the rear base and the amount of rice allotted daily, list is not dated and contains no unit designation, but is signed by Nguyen Xuan Hao, Unit Commander, no rank given, unit strength varies from 254 to 310 men.

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2/ List of unit #55 giving daily rear base strength and amount of rice issued. Daily rear base strength figures match exactly those in list # 1 above. List is for March 1965, no signature.

Directive

Directive # 211/CV of Ben Cat District Military Affairs Committee, dated 22 Jan 65 and signed by Lt Y, Governor of Military Affairs Committee, and agencies subordinate to the District, true copy to CB65 and B60 in lieu of reports, fixing activities of subordinate units in the period of 1965 Lunar New Year.

A/ Pre Lunar New Year period

1/ Stop up military activities from 22 Jan 65 to 30 Jan 65 causing maximum attrition to the enemy.

2/ Consolidate air and artillery shelters from 23 to 26 Jan 65, then on 27 Jan 65 visit and repair graves of soldiers KIA, and organize memorial ceremony.

3/ CB1, Special action, and engineer units to attack axes of communications or chief towns of the district to gain a great victory.

B/ During Lunar New Year period

1/ Switch to political and military proselyting activities. Stop buses and cars for armed propaganda, disseminate leaflets and organize fifth columnists.

2/ Limit leaves of cadre, soldiers and personnel working at various agencies.

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1/ Set up military, political and proselyting activities, beginning the fifth day of the Lunar New Year, striving to gain some initial successes.

2/ Destroy enemy strategic hamlets and transform them into combat hamlets.

Letter

Letter from C.15 sent with 6 weapons to H.55, a VC Labor Unit, stating that the weapons are to be kept by H.55 until orders are received telling H.55 which units to deliver the weapons to. Letter dated 31 March 1965, signed by NH.T, Comrade of C.15.

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Issue Order

An order from C.15, dated 8 October 1965, and signed by Tien Nam, Commander of C.15 issuing 1 Box of K.44 ammo + 44 shells to the Dien Ban Unit.

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Weapons + Ammunition Receipts

9 weapons + ammunitions receipts from H.55 to various village units, all dated 14 April 1965, and signed by Nguyen Xuan Hao, Commander of H.55.
