Troop information material, depicting US 17th Fleet as obsolete, consisting mostly of carriers and cruisers that can be easily destroyed by missiles. Whereas, the USSR Far East Fleet has 100 submarines with nuclear weapons against 20 submarines of the 7th Fleet. Morale is low and the 7th Fleet twice had to retreat before threats of U.S. in 1957 in Middle East and of Red China in the Quemoy affair in 1959.

Memorandum LSA/SV dated 29 [illegible] 1965 signed by Hai Chinh to 4 KH, City Unit, and agencies and units subordinate to HP, giving their instructions concerning the celebration of the 20th anniversary of the [VC] 19 Aug Revolution and the [VC] Independence Day (2 September). Basis should be placed on indoctrination of revolutionary traditions such as: ardent patriotism, hatred against imperialists and feudalists, will to bear hardships, etc... To the masses, efforts should be made to heighten their confidence in the ultimate victory of the Party as shown in the 19 August revolution example.


