Their duties consist of dispatching agents to North Vietnam, countering VC activities in RVN-controlled areas and collecting information on VC base areas.

Exploitation Service, aka "Northern" Service:

It has branches in Hue, Da Nang, Laos and Bankok. It sends agents to North Vietnam. Some of these agents remain there for long range operations, others leave upon accomplishment of their specific mission.

Terrain Exploitation Service:

Special Forces of the U.S. Military Command in Saigon, directly subordinate to the CIA. They have a separate headquarters with one RVN officer and one U.S. General in command. This headquarters is located in Nha Trang and consists of two elements:

1/ Headquarters, Group 77:

Brigadier General Powell and Captain Phan Huy Tat.

Five training camps: Mang Ca, Nam Dong, Hoa Cam, Thu Duc and Song Mao.

2/ Special Forces Training Headquarters:

Major General Lac Bo Kiep [sic] and one RVNAF officer.

Plei Mo Rong training center and 30 other training camps in South Vietnam.

U.S. Special Forces:

Under the command of Colonel Leonard. Headquarters (Special Forces Operations Base) located at Nha Trang airfield.

Intelligence Collection Detachment:

I CTZ Intelligence Collection Command Section located in Hue.

II CTZ Intelligence Collection Command Section located in Banmethuot.

Combined Security and Intelligence Committee:

From province to village levels. The province chief is the chairman of the province committee, with representatives of the various intelligence organizations as members. The same organization is set up in the district. The chairman of the village council is chairman of the village committee consisting of representatives of the village council and self-defense forces.

	<p><u>Combined U.S.-Vietnamese Committee:</u></p> <p>Supreme headquarters of U.S. and RVN intelligence agencies.</p> <p><u>U.S Intelligence Committee:</u></p> <p>Designated O.T. Under O.T. is A.V.H., and under A.V.H. are the elements of the various regions divided into cells. Follow-up political struggle movements to uncover VC backbone cadre and traitors within RVN ranks.</p> <p><u>Military Intelligence:</u></p> <p>Under Thi's command in I CTZ G-2 at division and regiment levels, S-2 at battalion level. At company level, intelligence work is assumed by an MCC. Civil Guards and Self-Defense Forces Intelligence is handled by the Civil Guards Provincial Command.</p> <p><u>National Police:</u></p> <p>Under the command of Lieutenant Colonel Phan Ngoc Lieu. Three divisions: Special Police, now designated security Police Administration</p> <p>Eight branches: Special Police Judicial Police Combat Police Administration Laboratory Immigration Police Traffic Police Training.</p> <p>Seven Police Directorates totalling 20,000 agents. The National Police are under the supervision of USOM Public Safety Division.</p> <p><u>Military Security:</u></p> <p><u>People's Intelligence:</u></p> <p>Handled by the province and district chiefs. Agents operate in strategic hamlets and RVN controlled areas.</p> <p><u>Covert Intelligence Organizations:</u></p> <p>Malaria Eradication Program, Rural Areas Pacification Cadre Group, Social Welfare Activity Group, etc.</p>

12-1652-65	<p>Personal letter</p> <p>Personal letter dated 24 Feb 64 from P's mother, in Quang Ngai, to Dung and his brother.</p> <p>[Information extracted:]</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Heading of the letter reads as follows: From Nguyen Thi Dung, (Dung's wife) in Nghia Trang, Tu Nghia, Quang Ngai, to Nguyen Tien Dung in Khanh Hoa. - Dung and his brother have been away from home for 12 years. - Their mother misses them very much and longs for their return. - She claims she never knows freedom. - A handwritten note dated 10 April 64 by Thanh Van, Tu Nghia District, Quang Ngai, states that she has twice forwarded letters from Dung to his family. Van also sends her greeting to Dong, Tung and Bien. Informs Dung that Dong's wife has remarried, and asks him to urge the above individuals to write home.
